


# INSTRUCTIONS TO ACCESS THE UNISA MOOC SITE

## STEP 01: ENTER THE MOOC URL


To go to the Unisa MOOC site, enter the following URL into your Internet Browser



First click on “MEMBERSHIP”




After clicking “MEMBERSHIP”, click “JOINABLE SITES”


### STEP 04: Go to the MOOC

For others, this may be the beginning of a new journey as you start your studies after school or after a break from your studies. We hope that this MOOC has helped you decide whether studying through Unisa is for you.

To recap, you got an idea of what is required to study successfully through Unisa (self-discipline and self-directed learning were really important concepts here). You also learnt about the differences between ODeL and full-time contact study. In our discussion we explained that we use technology in a distance education context to remove the distance between lecturers and students, and that because in a distance education context students do not interact with their lecturers in person every day, lecturers may not notice immediately when students are experiencing difficulties. You also learnt about some of the things that make studying by means of ODeL difficult. Are you perhaps a first-generation student who has to juggle the responsibilities of working and studying at the same time?
