

M&D Qualifications Excluded admission via – RPL

The RPL for access to M&D route is not available for admission for direct access into Master's and Doctoral degrees. Applications are accepted based on the minimum admission requirements as published for the Masters and Doctoral studies site. Student must apply via the traditional route. The following qualifications are affected:

CLAW - School of Law

Students applying for LLM/LLD must have a completed LLB degree or Postgraduate Diploma in Law at NQF Level 8 to be admitted to the LLM/LLD degree, it is a requirement by the College of Law.

CHS - Master of Arts in Development Studies (98412)

The departmental requirements are that students who do not meet the minimum requirement of 60% average for the BA Honours should complete two of the honours modules that they have not registered for as part of the BA Hons degree, for non-degree purposes. This is to give applicants the opportunity to improve their average mark to 60% or above. Only the highest five marks will be considered in calculating the average mark.

Students are referred to apply via the RPL route after they have applied with the College of Graduate Studies and denied admission, offered to register for NDP modules. Only once students have gone this route, and still not met the requirements, can they be given the opportunity to apply via RPL.
