Postponement of Unisa's Post-budget speech discussion

The University of South Africa (Unisa) regrets to inform the media and stakeholders that the seventh post-Budget Speech discussion, jointly hosted by the Colleges of Accounting Sciences (CAS) and Economic and Management Sciences (CEMS), has been postponed. This is due to the postponement of the 2025 Budget Speech by the Minister of Finance, which was originally scheduled for yesterday, 19 February 2025.

The event, themed 'South Africa's G20 Presidency: Being Efficient, Effective and Resilient in *Turbulent Times*', was set to take place on Friday, 21 February 2025, at the Unisa Muckleneuk Campus. Given that the discussion is centred on key insights from the Budget Speech, it will be rescheduled to align with the Minister's new address date.

A new date for the event will be communicated in due course. Unisa appreciates the continued support of industry leaders, media representatives, and stakeholders and looks forward to engaging in critical discussions on South Africa's economic landscape at the rescheduled event.
