City hosts tea party

300 residents of Reuven Senior Centre enjoyed a party to celebrate the women's march

MORE than 300 residents of Reuven Senior Centre in Turffontein, south of Johannesburg, enjoyed a tea party to celebrate the 61st anniversary of the women's march to Parliament on August 9, 1956.

The city of Johannesburg's Section 79 committees chair of chairs, Mohammed Alex Christians, attended the event with a member of the mayoral committee for health and social development, Mpho Malase, four committee chairpersons and several councillors from the area.

The elderly residents were treated to tea, coffee and sandwiches as the Johannesburg metro police department's brass band, which has in its history endeared itself to many audiences, provided the musical backdrop, belting out golden oldies such as Pata and Meadowlands, as well as similar gospel songs.

The senior citizens were also given advice tips by city official Clenecker-Harris and hand, neck and back massages by students from the University of Johannesburg.

"I did not realise they were going to give us massages. It was really nice," Erica Mokoena, 73, said.

Health workers were also on hand to check the elderly men and women's blood pressure, cholesterol and insulin levels.

Malase also encouraged the senior citizens to register for the city's expanded social grant package (ESGP), an improved social grant for the indigent.

Christians urged the elderly to contact their public representatives should they need assistance with any municipal-related issue.

"Our role is to ensure that the executive does its job. We oversee the governance of the city," Christians said.

Reuven Senior Centre houses 320 elderly men and women.

"I moved here nine years ago from Meadowlands," Carolline Nguasheng, 71, said. "I like helping out in the office and today in the kitchen. I'm happy they are hosting this event for us. This is a lonely place, especially at night when you are all by yourself in your flat. So you have to keep busy during the day."

Nguasheng said she volunteered with a group of five women who knit and crochet. "Last month we donated 90 scarves and beanies to the Adelaide Tambo Home in Soweto for Mandela Day. We have to plough back into the community but we need donations of wool. I also play bowls at the Turffontein Bowling Club," she said.

Belinda Nkosi, 81, formerly of Vosloorus, Ekurhuleni, has been at the home since 1994. She said that of her 10 children, only three were still alive.

"I worked for the municipality for 30 years. Now I am being taken good care of here. To keep busy, I help with the cleaning. Every Sunday I go to Rhema church, where I have been a member for 32 years," Nkosi said.

At the end of the event, the elderly men and women were handed small bags with vegetables, fruit and juice.

Christians and his team recently launched a vegetable garden, which Johannesburg City Parks and Zoo will help maintain.
