
## Key changes for students



# NOTES ON THE USE OF THIS GUIDE:



1. During July 2023, Unisa updated its myModules Learning Management System to improve your online learning experience as a student. The purpose of this guide is to inform you about the changes on myModules which you should take note of.

# DASHBOARD PAGE



1. The *Dashboard* tab moved to the top navigation bar
2. The user profile name is no longer displayed in full. Only the user initials are displayed on the profile section. If a user uploads a profile picture, the initials will be replaced by the picture.
3. The navigation drawer is no longer displayed in the dashboard page.

# COURSE SEARCH FUNCTIONALITY




4. Users can now access a specific course through a search function located on the myModules drop-down menu.
5. A block drawer can be expanded or collapsed using this symbol.

# COURSE SETTINGS MENU


