
myModules Profile Photo




You are now required to have an updated profile photo on myModules to confirm your identity. The profile photos may be used to confirm your identity against proctoring tool images to ensure academic integrity.

Follow the steps below to upload a photo as your profile picture on myModules:

1. Login to <https://my.unisa.ac.za/>
2. Click on the **MyModules 2022** button in the header.



3. In the **top right corner**, click on your **Name** and then on the **Profile** option in the dropdown menu.



4. On your profile page click on the **Edit profile** link in the **User details** section.







6. If you chose the file upload option from the previous step, you will need to **Choose a file** from your device and then click the **Upload this file** button.




7. Your photo should now appear in the upload box.
